



The markbook is extremely flexible and most courses will use one of the following types of markbook structure:


Type 1 – Units only




Type 2 – Units and Assessments




Type 3 – Units, Assessments and Criteria




Type 4 – Assessments only

Type 6- Assessments and Criteria



- For a Unit based course (e.g. Access to HE) you may wish to simply track Units - Type 1
- City & Guilds, CACHE and HE courses (FDeg and Deg) often have Assessments within Units – Type 2
- The standard graded vocational model uses all three levels - Type 3
- For A levels or GCSE you can simply track Assessments - Type 4
- An ‘NVQ’ style model may have Criteria being delivered within Units but without fixed Assessments – Type 5
- You may wish to track Assessments with sub-criteria within them – Type 6
